In a voting session, all members of the association give their vote on the shortlisted issues that should be considered



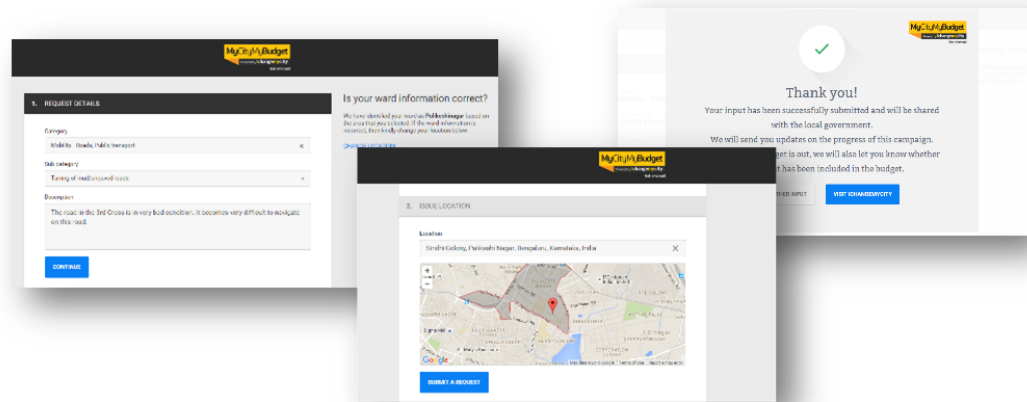
### Prioritization
