We, the students thought at first that the second visit would make us boring but towards the end, it turned out to be an exciting and gaining a valuable information for each and every student.

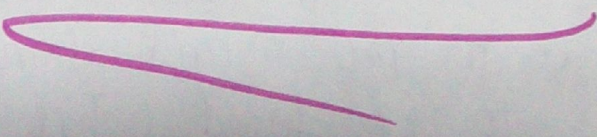
