BBMP Lends Helping Hand To Rehabilitate Flood-Hit Kodagu

The flood-hit Kodagu needs manpower the most, to come back to normalcy. BBMP not only dispatched truck-loads of relief material but also sent more than 320 officials and workers to help in rehabilitation operations undertaken in Kodagu.

The officials and Swachhata team from BBMP joined hands with the Kodagu district administration and helped clearing water filled in houses in Kushalnagar as well as cleaning the surroundings to avoid outbreak of diseases.

Donating salaries

BBMP's 198 corporators have decided to donate one month honorarium and BBMP employees have decided to donate their one day salary to help people affected due to floods in Kodagu.

Rs 1 crore each for Kodagu and Kerala

Rs 1 crore has been released as relief fund from BBMP to Kodagu district flood affected areas and Rs 1 crore to Kerala state flood affected areas through Karnataka Chief Minister Relief fund.

Pada Yatra For Awareness

All Zonal Additional/Joint Commissioners and Chief Engineers took out a pada yatra (awareness walk) along with their subordinates to create awareness among public to donate food and relief material for flood ravaged Kodagu and Kerala.



Defence Team Inspects Land In Anekal Taluk

In lieu of prime defence lands being given in Bengaluru city for 10 infrastructure projects by the defence ministry, the state government had signed an agreement with them to give 207.29 acres in exchange that comprises three survey numbers No 23, 176, and 177 in Thammanayakanahalli village.

A defence team comprising senior officers from the Karnataka-Kerala Sub area and officials from BBMP inspected the land at Thammanayakanahalli survey numbers in Anekal taluk on August 10.



BBMP Not To Collect Fee From Organizations Which Set-Up Ganesh Pandals

No tax or fee will be collected from organisations who wish to set-up pandals ahead of the Ganesh festival. The Mayor has informed in a press release to not pay heed to people who are collecting money from people in the name of BBMP. He clarified that BBMP is not collecting any such fee. However, along with celebrations he requested people to take care of cleanliness in the city.



Traffic Diversion On ORR Due To White Topping Work

BBMP has started the white topping work on Outer Ring Road from Hebbal flyover junction to Hennur road junction and Symmanahalli flyover junction to Nayandhalli junction.

Vehicles plying from Hebbal flyover junction to Hennur shall divert on left side service road and one lane in main carriageway to reach Hennur junction till November 11, 2018.

Vehicles plying from Summanahalli junction should take left side service road to reach Nayandalli junction till October 26, 2018.
