- Establishment of a data Bank of agriculture to give input sales.
- Digitization at the ground level to drive personalized and data driven farm extension, realistic crop loss compensation and insurance.
- A Government scheme to pay farmers the difference between the official minimum support price and the average market rates for commercial crops grown by them.
- A Government scheme to connect the agricultural department's scientific and technical staff with the state's farming community.
- Encouragement for food processing units at every taluk of the state.
- Encouragement for Agro based industries in all the districts of the State.
- Providing modern cold storage units at every taluk of the State.
- Establishment of Agricultural Universities and Agricultural Research centers to



promote and develop the agricultural Sector.

- 30 per cent of the cost of fertilizer and machines used for farming under co-operative societies would be borne by the Government.

- 30 per cent grant to the co-operative societies formed by rural agricultural woman who are engaged in flower cultivation, fishery, pottery, poultry farming and other agro products.
- Subsidy up to Rs. 15000/- will be provided for small and micro farmers for purchasing new electric motors.
- Payment of adequate compensation to the farmers for the land in farm lands for



erecting electricity towers.

- Introduction of crop insurance scheme to provide compensation to the farmers for destruction of crop due to wild animals besides natural calamity.
- Arrangement will be made to encourage sericulture by setting up silk cocoons sales centers in needy districts and to get appropriate price for silkworm nest produced.
